NEW CHURCH SOFTWARE TO AID IN UPDATING CONGREGATIONAL INFORMATION AND GIVING

Fremont is converting to a new church management software package (ShelbyNext) that, among many other things, will help members of the congregation to keep their information current and to set up recurring electronic giving if they so desire. Over the next several weeks, those attending on Sundays will be briefed on how to set up individual member access, download a new Fremont app for their smartphone or tablet, set up automatic and recurring giving, and ultimately access information on church activities and calendars. A few simple steps that will be necessary to set up access to these services will be reviewed on Sunday mornings. The system will go live on July 1st, but setup of your individual member access can be accomplished any time on or after June 10th. More information will follow in the Loop and in other communications.
